

House Rules UWTC BMX Camping

BMX 3-Nations Cup, 6-8 September 2019

Dear guest,

UWTC is committed to make your stay during this event as pleasant as possible for you and your fellow guests. For this purpose, a set of rules and regulations have been drawn up, which you can find in these House Rules. We assume that each and every guest is aware of these rules and also that he/she shall adhere to them. Our staff members are authorized to ensure that these rules are observed and to point out any violation.

Arrival and Departure

- Arrival on Friday is possible from 12:00 hours.
- Upon departure, you are expected to leave your camp spot clean.

General

- The UWTC shall not be held responsible or liable for any damage and/or harm that may be caused as a result of staying at the campsite, or for any damage suffered as a result of the use of the available services (facilities) on site.
- The UWTC shall not be liable for any damage claims resulting from noise or odour nuisance and from any external calamity, neither for the state of the site as a consequence of weather conditions.
- No liability shall be accepted for the break-down and/or failure of the available facilities and/or services.
- Everyone stays entirely at their own risk.
- UWTC and its staff are at all times entitled to deny trespassers and/or people who misbehave access to the site.
- All cases not specified under these regulations shall be subject to the UWTC Camp Coordinator's decision.

Campsite

- Due to organizational purposes, spots will be allocated as decided by the Camp Coordinator. It is not allowed to switch places on your own initiative.
- Night rest shall be observed from 22:00 to 7:00 hours. It is then forbidden to play music or to produce any other kind of noise at the campsite.
- Open fire or camp fires are not allowed at, around or outside the camping area. Barbecuing at the campsite is only allowed using gas or electrical appliances.
- Adults who are responsible for children must ensure that other guests are not disturbed by them.
- In line with the Fire Department's orders, it is compulsory to carry an approved fire extinguisher per camping means.

Garbage

- Upon your arrival, you will be provided with a big garbage bag for your waste. Upon departure, you are expected to throw it away in the large disposal container at the entrance of the campsite. Please make sure to close your garbage bag before throwing it away in the container.

Pets

- The campsite and surrounding grounds are no outlets for dogs; there are enough outlet routes in the vicinity. Should your pet inadvertently do his need on the campsite, you must clean it up yourself.
- Pets may not be a nuisance to other camping guests.
